**Job Description:** Vineyard Assistant

**Summary:** Our vineyard is an integral part of the overall winery operation

and essential to producing high quality wines. In this part-time position, you will be active in helping to grow and maintain the vines throughout the growing season and dormant season. The position includes a mix of weekday and weekend work.

## **Essential Functions:**

- 1. Performing vineyard duties of pruning, checking shoot positions, vine training and pest and disease identification.
  - 2. Keep vineyard records of cultural practices.
  - 3. Coordinates workflow and makes daily work assignments.
  - 4. Monitors vine health, notifies owners of findings, and may recommend changes to established procedures.
  - 5. Participates in planning for vineyard development and maintenance.
  - 6. Operates a variety of vineyard equipment such as tractors, forklifts, trucks, mowers, sprayers and ATV's. Maintains vineyard equipment as needed.
  - 7. Purchases miscellaneous vineyard supplies within established limits.
  - 8. Assists with wine production and order procurement.
  - 9. Performs special projects as assigned.

## **Qualifications:**

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

- 1. At least 2 years of prior experience working in horticultural operations.
- 2. Ability to perform specialized vineyard duties such as pruning, checking shoot positions and vine training.
- 3. Ability to identify pest and disease problems in the vineyard.

- 4. Ability to operate and do basic maintenance on vineyard equipment, such as mowers, sprayers, tractors and trucks.
- 5. Excellent communication, influence, and negotiation skills are required in order to work effectively with a variety of people. Ability to read and write English.
- 6. Basic mathematical skills and strong detail orientation are required in order to calculate and monitor vineyard operations.
- 7. Reasoning skills, judgment and problem-solving skills are required in order to coordinate multiple activities; analyze and resolve problems, and represent the winery to the public.
- 8. Demonstrated ability to effectively foster teamwork and motivate excellent performance is required. Ability to supervise and train vineyard workers to use proper vineyard operation techniques quickly and safely.
- 9. PHYSICAL DEMANDS: This position requires the following levels of physical activity: Extensive (2/3 of the time) standing, walking, lifting 40-50 pounds, using hands to operate machinery, reaching with hands and arms, stooping, kneeling and crouching; Moderate (1/3 of the time) talking, hearing, tasting and smelling. This position requires the following visual capabilities: close and distance, color, peripheral vision and adjustment of focus.
- 10. WORK ENVIRONMENT: This position entails exposure to the following environmental conditions: Extensive (2/3+ of the time) humid or outdoor weather conditions and working near 'moving mechanical parts; The noise level exposure for this position is moderate.
